



Clean Diesel Grant Projects

OCSS and the Ozarks Clean Air Alliance (OCAA) have successfully acquired funding through the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) for reducing diesel pollution in Southwest Missouri. These projects will help improve air quality in Southwest Missouri communities. The funding was acquired through two grants.

The first grant was the Transform Missouri Metropolitan Clean Diesel Project. OCSS partnered with the Missouri Department of Natural Resources (MDNR) Air Pollution Control Program to apply for the funding. This project included replacing 13 older, more polluting, buses with new buses that meet the 2007 or 2010 EPA emission limits. It also included retrofitting 98 older buses with Diesel Oxidation Catalysts (DOC's) to reduce the amount of pollution emitted from each bus. The participants in the grant included 10 public school districts in Southwest Missouri. The following is a list of the funded projects and contact information:
